Promise and Peril of AI for SMEs



In the generative AI era, one may suggest the accelerated implementation of AI across products, services, and applications to convey digital progress and innovation to potential clients and audiences. In many cases, AI features have become almost a synonym for a product's success and commerciality, without truly accounting for the existing limitations of such technologies for SMEs.

The widespread AI development may mislead businesses to posit that all case studies can benefit from this technology and its various methods, and even attempt to fabricate increased associations between product features and AI for marketing purposes.

This brief article will discuss the limitations and bottlenecks of AI in the business sector and demystify three common perceptions in a bid to promote a critical and accurate delivery of data-driven ventures using AI methods.

Al can predict the future.

Despite the suggested promise of predictive analytics, AI cannot yet predict the future. Any declarations on AI curating insights or recommendations for future actions should be more nuanced and clarify the algoritmic modus operandi. As such, AI methods still rely on previous datasets to calculate the probability of certain scenarios happening. As AI methods have become more complex and multimodal, particularly deep learning and NLP, one may argue that data accuracy will increase.

However, when it comes to unplanned scenarios and mutations yet to occur in human history, requiring advanced judgement, creativity, and empathy, AI is more likely to reinforce historical biases and not be fully accurate. The increased data biases and errors in medical diagnosis during the COVID-19 pandemic can support this claim and emphasise the lack of full autonomy. Another known AI failure in the medical space is attributed to IBM, which tried to develop a predictive system for combating cancer. Evidence published in The Verge suggested the failure of the system and the curation of inaccurate and false recommendations, worsening the patients' condition.

Therefore, unexpected product cycles might face obstacles using AI, compared to more repetitive tasks and processes, with previous testing data for the machine to learn from. In other words, AI can primarily predict futuristic scenarios by analysing previous outputs and, therefore, replicating existing trends and biases. Future developments in deep learning and NLP might enhance these capabilities and reinforce the human thinking process of algorithms, thus making them more autonomous.

2) Al can increase diversity and inclusion.

Al has been widely used to increase diversity and inclusion across business sectors, particularly recruitment and educational processes, to ensure fairer chances for one's applications. Several Al tools rely on previous datasets to provide smart recommendations on the most relevant skills and characteristics of successful hires and applicants. This can potentially increase the applications' conversion rate as the machine prioritises candidates based on their relevant features and avoids biases related to deterministic features such as religion, ethnicity, and gender.

Nonetheless, previous Al-driven hiring tools have shown the paradox of such solutions in recruitment processes. On the one hand, recruiters can receive smart recommendations and diversify their talent pool. On the other hand, these tools also include biases within their datasets, particularly relying on previous hiring decisions.

For example, AI tools still reinforce gender biases in STEM positions since most hired candidates are males, and therefore the tool will accurately analyse this gender probability by increasing conversion through gender bias. Due to the existing socio-cultural factors impacting the number of female applicants in STEM positions, there is a need for revised data metrics and debiasing methods.

Consequently, technical teams are required to develop debiasing tools, set diversity and inclusion goals per category, and moderate the biases of previous datasets when using Al solutions to screen applications. This implies that Al usage does not fully guarantee product quality and fariness, and biases can still resurface across the product lifecycle.

3) Al will replace humans

As Stephen Hawking told th BBC, "The development of full artificial intelligence could spell the end of the human race... It would take off on its own and re-design itself at an ever-increasing rate. Humans, who are limited by slow biological evolution, couldn't compete and would be superseded."

The literature around AI ethics has discussed the potential scenario of singularity and humans being replaced by machines. While AI progress has accelerated in recent years, the computational capabilities of AI are still limited compared to humans when it comes to creativity, thinking outside of context, emotional intelligence, and unexpected scenarios.

A possible replacement can occur in places where human functionality is repetitive and relatively planned. This notion has a substantial effect on traditional professions considered to be simpler in scope and without much judgment. Consequently, while AI does not seem to replace humans in the near future, certain professions might go through evolutionary processes, as not all workers will be relevant in the new workforce.

This can lead to the removal of certain industries and the reduction of junior positions, requiring employees to exercise the skills of creativity and complex judgement, or, more simply, provide added value compared to a machine that can do an abundant number of calculations in a given time.

Design Thinking: A Roadmap for Creative Problem Statement

Date: 9th - 10th May, 2024

Day 1 was led by the brilliant Ms. Swati Adhikary, Founder-Infuse Studio and Innovation Specialist. Participants were introduced to the concept of Design Thinking and its three pillars: Empathy, Ideation, and Experimentation. Students were introduced to five mindsets crucial for successful innovation: Explore, Think-Act-Repeat, Reframing, Try Things, and Ask for Help. One of the session's main takeaways was learning about the components of successful inventions, which included business viability, technological feasibility, and human desirability. The Design Thinking phases: Empathy, Define, Ideate, Prototype, and test were discussed, along with the significance of identifying user behaviours, pain areas, and preferences. Major takeaways also included selection criteria, the SCAMPER approach and significance of attractiveness as a means of producing new ideas through the manipulation of pre-existing ones. Last but not the least summary of the Minimum Viable Product (MVP) idea was given to wrap up the discussion.







Designing The Future: From Concept to Reality

Date: 9th - 10th May, 2024

Day 2 of the event featured Idea pitching from 15 different teams; each team presented an innovative startup idea. Some notable pitches included Compact and portable infants feeding bottle with automatic Sterilisation, Smart flow Agritech, Smart sole for accurate foot tracking, multi-temperature vaccine box, and Aushadimate, an IoT-based medicine storage device with reminders. Other pitches ranged from solutions for agriculture, health, safety, education, and technology platforms connecting like-minded individuals. The teams were judged on the basis of innovation, feasibility, market potential, business model, and team competence.

The top three Startup Ideas who excelled in the pitching:

First Place: Aushadimate - A Smart Pill Reminder Box.

Second Place: SnapDoc - Al-powered study material analysis tool.

Third Place: Cigarette Smoke Exhale Filter - An attachment device to filter harmful smoke.



Innovation to Startup in Manufacturing Sector



Journey from innovation to manufacturing. In other words, from innovation to start-up. If manufacturing is not my goal, then innovation in itself is not my goal.

When a person aspires to be an entrepreneur, the first word that comes to mind is startup. And when we talk of start-up in manufacturing, the first question that we face is – "What" to make? It takes great effort and care to find the answer. Because this "what" determines the direction of innovation ahead and of entrepreneur as well.

What is innovation? And Who will take up the responsibility

of innovation and applied R&D – that will take the idea from innovation through prototype to a final product?

New entrepreneurs do not know all this. Here if some experienced hands can hold his hand, then he can take the idea to the product. Here comes the role and responsibility of entrepreneurship promotion and incubation cells. They need to have the ability, capability, infrastructure, and experience – to build on an idea and to take it to the product level.

And under that, so many schemes are being made for startups. But this is just the beginning. The journey is long. Similarly, entrepreneurship is also a career option. But a difficult option. Its prerequisite is the ability to take risk. Which not everyone has. Also, there are no specific colleges for that, where real life entrepreneurs are giving training. But this also requires specialized training!! My suggestion is that the government should also prepare such schemes, in which they can attract and motivate real life entrepreneurs to share their experiences with new entrepreneurs and for expert mentorship. I believe that it can work as a catalyst and booster.



CROSSING FRONTIERS

"10 years back > 10 years forward My thoughts and prediction on our Tech Ecosystem"



My first steps in the tech and entrepreneurship world, at an all-grown-up job was officially ten year ago this month. I originally planned to become a diplomat and my extra curriculum projects as head of students and internship at the Indian Embassy in Israel during my east Asian studies in Tel-Aviv University were just to fill in the little time I had, If any, between studies and 4 hours of sleep a night.

The last 10 years have laid down crucial infrastructure for us. The rise of online communities, shared data platforms on social media and websites, has changed how and where we consume news and seek advice for our daily or important life events. The COVID-19 pandemic has taught us about global

and breaking geographical boundaries, leading to increased remote work and virtual collaboration with colleagues across different time zones. This is a significant shift from the days when I used to travel by plane for important meetings or conferences.

The technologies we expected to dominate the next century Iled crypto currency, cyber, NFTs, Nano-Robotics, IoT, and smart devices. Surprisingly, everyday tools like FinTech and payment apps, as well as messaging apps like WhatsApp and social media influencers on platforms like YouTube and Instagram, emerged as significant influences over the past decade. These innovations have paved the way for more advanced technological platforms that will continue to improve our lives and society. And as a Sci-Fi Geek I've been waiting for this era to come.

The next 10 years will be ruled by AI (Artificial Intelligence). However, contrary to common belief, most AI tools and products will enhance our natural skills. We'll have to learn how and when to master them as we strive to improve in our industry. Additionally, there will be a greater emphasis on soft skills that technology cannot replace – skills that only experience and the "daily hustle" can provide.

From my perspective, we'll need to focus more on social and soft skills as AI continues to rise. Emotional intelligence and intrapersonal intelligence, in my view, are the two most crucial of the "8 Intelligences Theory" for becoming a tech leader. Cultivating a broad network of colleagues, embracing mistakes as learning opportunities, bouncing back stronger, interpreting situations with nuance, adapting as you go, growing your inter-cultural knowledge and creativity thinking are the skills I've gained in my diverse pan-Asian Middle-Eastern ecosystem, and are valuable once we grow in our career.

I always argue that I earned those skills through blood, sweat, and tears. I wish I could have an AI tool to help me learn better, but as I spend more time in this ecosystem, I've come to realize that some mistakes are inevitable. Those are the lessons or summits you have to climb to deliver an actual tech product to tackle a real-life pain – which, at the end of the day, are the basics of starting a startup, an early-stage tech company. It doesn't matter the sector or the industry – technology inventions, evolutions, or novelties are meant to serve and better humanity during this crazy ride we call "life", not the other way around.


